# Demonstration of technical and Visual Skills, Quality of Outcome, Demonstration of Creativity

- In general, the more successful images (3,5 and 9) are the ones that offer something in the way of composition.
- The overlayed images are quite complicated and it is difficult to read notions of good and bad.

### Image 01

- The most obviously negative image that sets a negative tone.
- Overlay less successful in terms of the relationship between photograph and drawing.
- Even though you are overlaying, you still need to watch your photographic image making.
- Perhaps feels a bit staged.

#### Image 02

- I get that this is to give the viewer an idea of what you do outside of caring for your children but I am not sure that is fits with the rest of the series?
- Less successful compositionally.

# Image 03

- This picture works well because there is some kind of formal relationship between the photograph and the drawing.
- The blue of your shirt and your pose work well with the drawn overlay.

### Image 04

- I am not sure what this one is communicating, downtime?
- Less successful relationship between drawing and photograph.
- Is it important for us to be able to read the writing?

#### Image 05

- Works well.
- The fact that the oval shape in the drawing echoes the shape of your head makes this image work.
- The brown horizontal of the drawing separates your head from your body.
- The child in the drawing seems to be stroking your head.

Less successful

- This one would be on the edge of inclusion in a final series.
- The matching clothes create a relationship between the drawing and the photograph.
